



The Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Authority (PPDA) operates a national Register of Providers (RoP) in accordance with Section 7(h) of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act No. 1, 2003 and Regulation 22 of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Regulations, 2003.

The RoP was launched in November 2009, and currently has over 3,000 registered providers of services, supplies and works to the Government of Uganda and its agencies. The RoP is used by Government agencies (Procuring and Disposing Entities (PDEs)) in their day-to-day procurement operations. PPDA through its online database of providers of works, services and goods to the Government of Uganda, calls upon all providers to register their profiles on this website in order to create a common pool of reliable and up-to-date information on the competencies of providers to Procuring and Disposing Entities (PDEs) who are to use the RoP as a tool in identifying suitable providers.

The following are the benefits of registering on the RoP:

- It provides increased visibility for providers through their online profiles that showcase their skills and experience to the PDEs;
- It acts as a source of identification for eligible providers to participate in preference schemes - where a PDE limits participation in the procuring process on the basis of nationality;
- It is a source of identification for eligible providers to participate in reservation schemes - where procurement of works, services and supplies has as its objective the development of a target group and community, by reserving certain public procurement contracts for such groups and communities;
- It provides instant online access to all bid opportunities in Government; and
- The RoP provides email alerts to the registered Providers on bidding opportunities.

The RoP also provides a number of benefits to PDEs:

- It is a reliable source of information on Providers;
- It offers a transparent and reliable Providers' data bank;
- It provides PDEs with a record of current and past contract performance of the Providers;
- The RoP expedites short listing for routine procurements;
- It is convenient for publication of procurement notices.
